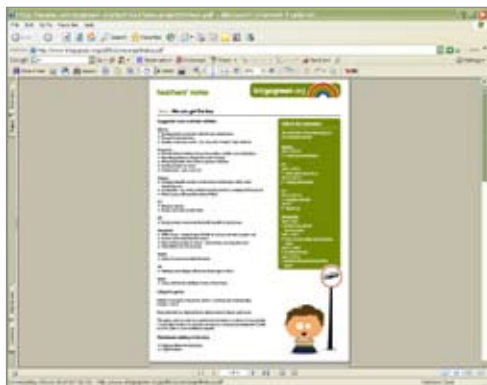

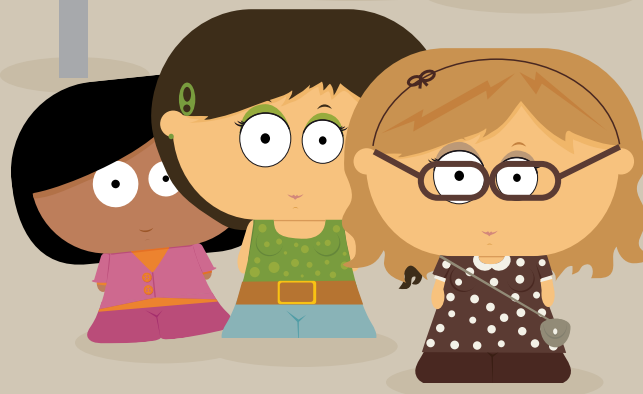
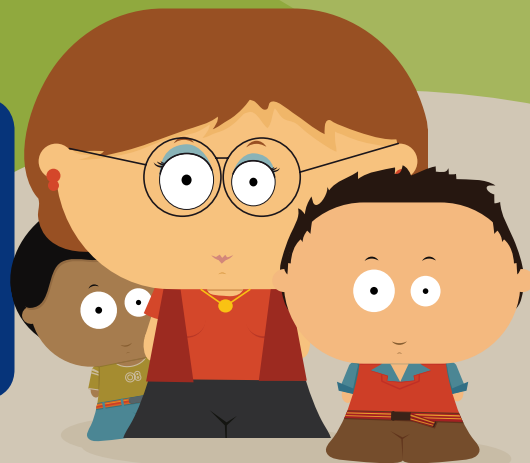

The **Letzgogreen** website has been developed and designed to help schools and pupils to understand and learn more about sustainable travel.

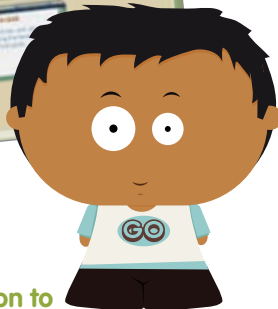
Letzgogreen teaches children the importance of issues such as climate change, congestion and health and helps raise awareness of the importance of using sustainable transport to help the environment.
